

Ithra Energy Exhibit

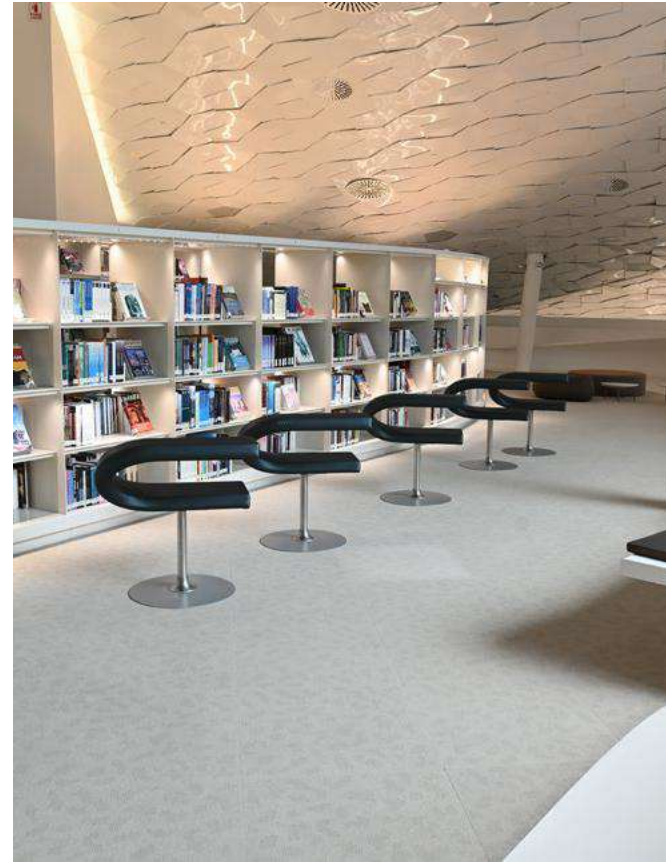


Ithra's ever-popular Energy Exhibit explores a world of discoveries in energy science through interactive displays, advanced technologies and multimedia. Established as a traveling exhibit in the 1950s by Saudi Aramco, the Energy Exhibit settled in its current location in the late 1980s,

when it was the only professional museum in the Eastern Province. It has evolved into a state-of-the-art facility that offers an exciting and engaging educational journey to explore how natural resources and alternative forms of energy are harnessed safely, efficiently and sustainably.



Ithra Library



Ithra Library is Saudi Arabia's first digitally integrated library. It is one of the largest public libraries in the region, with an ever-expanding collection of over 300,000 paper volumes in Arabic and English arranged across four floors. The Library also offers over one million audio and e-books. The Ithra Library hosts book signings

and special talks by prominent national and international guests, storytimes for children, literary competitions and oral history sessions. Ithra Library also runs the annual iRead national reading competition, a flagship Ithra program that has drawn more than 125,000 participants from all educational levels since 2013.
